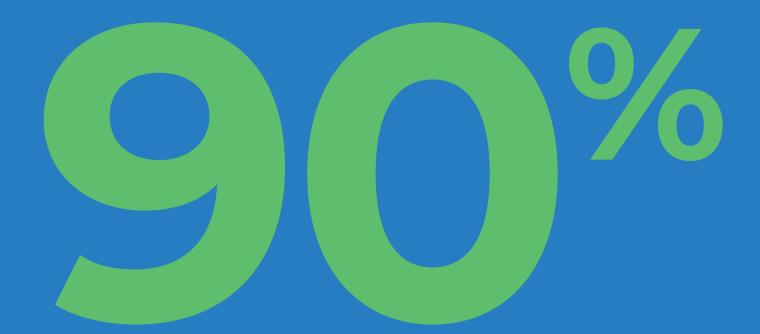

Our Business Models

We work with two complementary models to support our partner brands.

Agency Model

We provide sales support and market development on a commission basis. This model allows us to represent brands without taking ownership of stock. We are focusing on commercial growth and visibility.

Distribution Model

Here, we go a step further. Investing in stock, managing local inventory, and activating the brand through marketing efforts. This model enables us to take full responsibility for goto-market execution, offering stronger retail presence and deeper customer engagement.





Our operations are anchored in two strategic locations:

Edegem: A 500 m² office and showroom in a renovated barn, designed for immersive brand presentations and strategic meetings.

Lint: A 600 m² warehouse and logistics hub, ensuring fast and efficient distribution.

Both sites are centrally located in Belgium, with excellent access to major highways and the Port of Antwerp — ideal for serving the Benelux and beyond.

STRUCTURAL NGO PARTNERS

Natuurpunt

Natuurpunt is the largest nature association in Flanders. It advocates for nature and is engaged in its protection, experiencing and studying. We support the development of the Mechels Broek wetland area in Muizen, near Mechelen.

Proper Strandlopers:

Proper Strand Lopers or 'Clean Beach Runners' is a citizens' initiative to raise awareness and motivate people to tackle the problem of litter in the environment, especially at the coast. We support its daily operations (including organizing clean-ups and reporting on litter) and participates in clean-ups as well.

Protect Our Winters:

We support the Dutch and French branches of the international organization committed to inspiring outdoor sports fans to take climate action. Its support for these local chapters is focused on the Mobility Month project.

Zero Waste Nederland:

Zero Waste NL organizes the Week Zonder Afval (Week Without Waste), a zero waste campaign across the Netherlands in May. Elements provides financial, communication and in-kind support to inspire as many people as possible to create less waste.





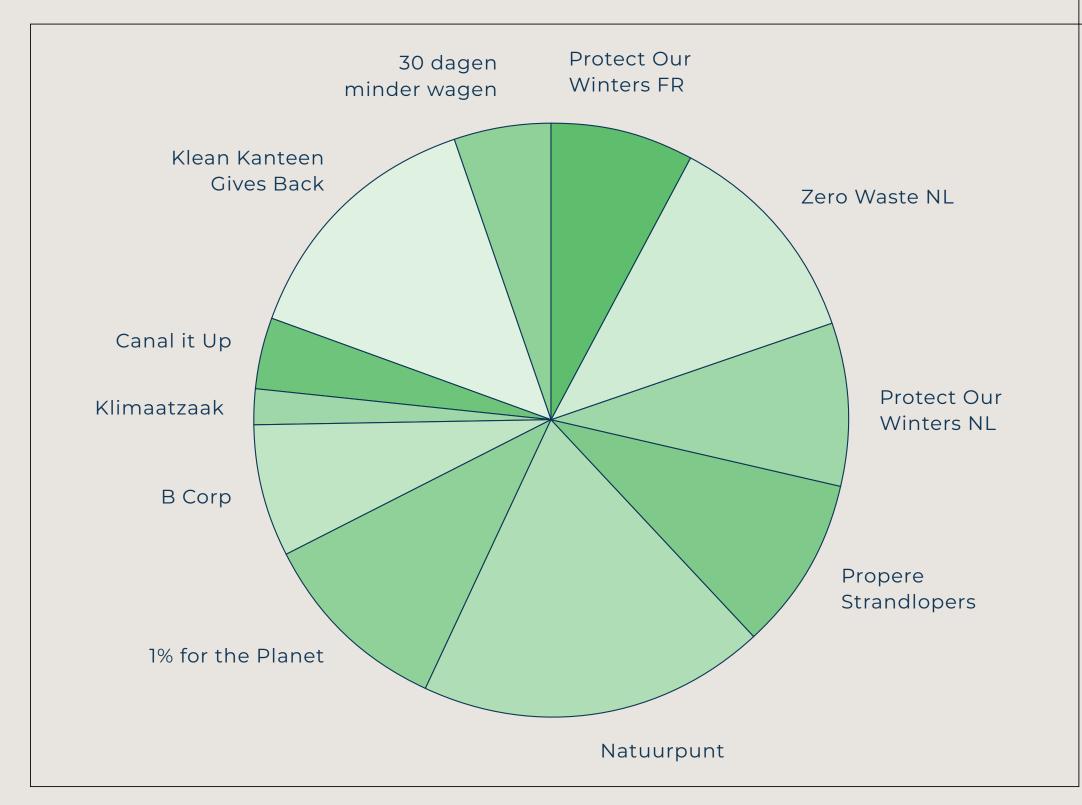


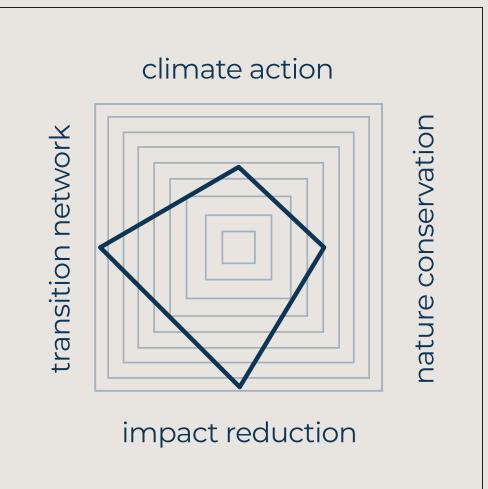




In 2024 we've crossed the line of €250.000 donations since 2019.

That's more than a quarter million for organizations that work on climate action, nature conservation, impact reduction and strengthening the transition network. That's over 30 organizations in 4 countries, from long term partnerships to single grants.





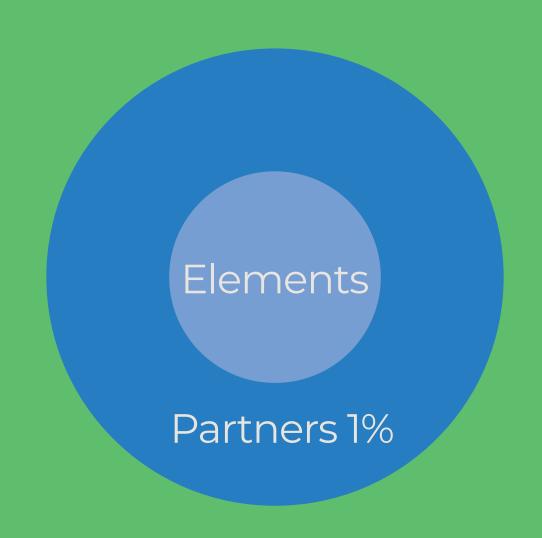
OUR 2024 SOCIO/ENVIRO IMPACT

Here's how we put that into practice in FY 2024 (05/2023-05/2024): In 2024 we've donated €56,193 to 12 organizations in Belgium, the Netherlands and France.

We score every organization we support on how they contribute to each of our 4 impact topics. We divide 4 points across the topics. When multiplied by our donations you get the visual above. Impact reduction and transition network are our most prominent topics because most organizations we support work on plastic pollution and almost all of our organizations contribute to policy work for sustainable practices in society.



As a PLANET member we donate 1% of our revenue directly to ngo's, but through purchasing and working with fellow 1FTP members we can amplify the impact of the network.



Indirectly we facilitate additional support for environmental ngo's by working with several 1% for the Planet brands and other partners – 1% of what we pay suppliers or sell as an agency goes to environmental ngo's.





Klean Kanteen **Gives Back is** our yearly grant campaign for local environmental organizations. In 2024 we distributed €8000 among 4 organisations.



KLEAN KANTEEN GIVES BACK

PLONS project by Odisee Hogeschool

The project PLONS, acronym for 'PLasticONderzoek in het Scheldestroom-gebied' (plastic research in the Scheldt river basin), aims to raise children's awareness of the plastic problem in the waterways. The methodology chosen is a citizen science project aimed at Flemish and Zeeland primary school children.

These children go through an educational, interactive process and are challenged to think about the plastic problem and how to solve it.

City to Ocean

Canal It Up works to solve three problems facing Brussels' waterways the canal and the Senne. These are floating waste, poor water quality and lack of nature and biodiversity. To this end, they are working out technical solutions, informing about the problems and sensibilising as many people as possible by organizing kayak trips 'plastic fishing' and other activities in the canal in central Brussels. We want to upgrade the waterways into a place where animals and plants are at home, where the water is clean and where it is simply nice to be.

Surfrider Foundation NL

Surfrider Foundation acts as an authority in three areas of expertise: marine litter, water quality and public health, coastal management and climate change.

Through campaigns, education, events, projects and partnerships, we work towards central, local and international goals, clean water, clean beaches and the protection of swimming/surfing spots.

Natuurpunt Druivenstreek

Natuurpunt Druivenstreek works
towards more and better nature in the
Druivenstreek municipalities of Hoeilaart,
Overijse, Tervuren and Huldenberg. We do
this by acquiring and managing nature
areas within 6 vision areas, enthusing the
public for nature through educational
activities and by talking to policy-makers.
This project gives a biodiversity boost
to the Old Trambed: a home for house

Based on these calculations, we develop a targeted reduction plan to actively lower our emissions within our company and across the supply chain.

We have a science-based target approved reduction goal for our scope 1+2 and monitor our scope 3 and have relative reduction goals. We are a committed member of the SME Climate Hub. Although relevant we realize the socio-environmental impact of our company goes beyond carbon emissions. Our policies are rooted in carbon footprint data and the sense that nature is family.



SME Climate Hub Commitment

We are member of SME Climate Hub, a global initiative that aims to integrate climate action into SMEs to enable SMEs to become resilient businesses of the future. We use SME Climate Hub's free tools to calculate our emissions.

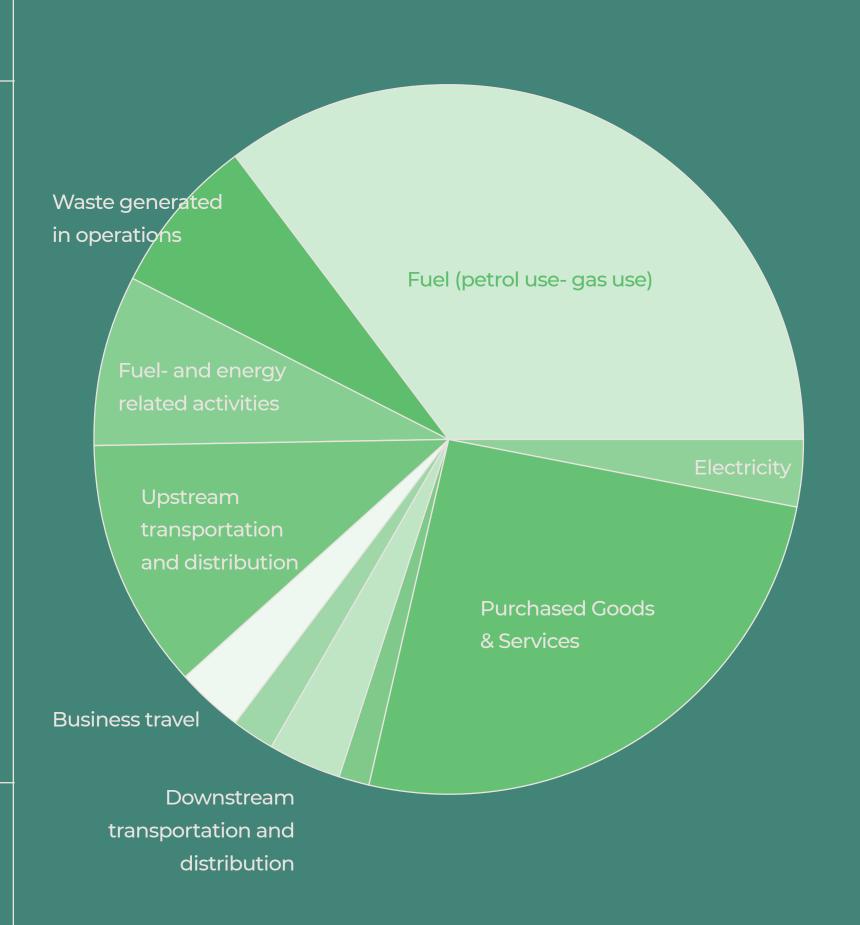

Our electricity use increased due to more charging of electric cars at our office.

Our gas use increased due to a heating problem in our warehouse (now solved)

Diesel use decreased, petrol use remain stable while electric charging increased, because we've added 3 electric cars to our fleet.

Our estimated scope 3 emissions are 117,3 tCO2e (see table for categories)

We've maintained our objective to import >90% products in weight by ocean freight (94,7%)
