FEIF Education Seminar

September, 23th – 25th, 2026, Iceland

The Education Committees of FEIF and LH invite you to an Education Seminar

23rd to 25th of September 2026

... the days before the Laufskálarétt horse roundup!

The main topic of the seminar will be **TRANSITIONS!**

With the help of some of our very best teachers we will look into various transitions between gaits, within gaits and starting tölt and pace training with young horses. We will also discuss how to teach transitions and what role the seat of the rider has in transitions. Extended practical sessions along with some theory parts about the science behind, will give us in-depth explanations and a unique experience with colleagues from multiple countries.

Venue

The seminar will take place in north-west Iceland, the beautiful Skagafjörður. The main venue will be Svaðastaðahöllin, riding hall, in Sauðárkrúkur, but we will also spend an afternoon in Hólar, the Equine University.

Teachers

Eyjólfur Ísólfsson is the Icelandic Horse professor and runs his company, Töltmaster. He is one of only 5 Master Trainers from Iceland, was the head riding teacher at Hólar University for 15 years, currently teaches courses all over the world and even holds a Professor status for Icelandic Horse riding within the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences. He is an encyclopedia of knowledge about training and teaching with decades of experience and among the most respected teachers in our Icelandic Horse world. See www.toltmaster.com

Árni Björn Pálsson is the reigning World Champion in T1, just won the Meistaradeild in Iceland for the 8th time, and has countless titles and wins throughout his career as one of the most successful competition rider and trainer in Iceland.

Dr Sigríður Björnsdóttir has been the head of Equine Veterinary in Iceland at the Veterinary Authorities for many years along with being among the most productive scientist in our Icelandic Horse community for decades herself. She has recently taken on a new role as a professor in Equine Science at Hvanneyri Agricultural University, working for the health and welfare of the Icelandic horse.

Hólar University and its team of riding instructors, their students and horses from the school will lead us through the start of both tölt and pace training and how to teach those early very important transitions. Linking into the ISES 10 training principles as well and discussing the development in teaching both horse and rider.

Mette Mannseth is one of the 5 Icelandic Master Trainers and the Head Ridingteacher at Hólar University. She has been extremely successful competition rider, trainer and breeder for many years, but probably is still most known as a fabulous teacher with wealth of experience and insight. Pórarinn Eymundsson is one of the 5 Master Trainers in Iceland. He has been a teacher at Hólar Equine University since almost 25years, and teaches elsewhere too, along with breeding, training and competing on highest level. With many titles in this sport under his belt, Pórarinn is certainly one of our best known horse man and a wealth of experience and knowledge.

Ísólfur Línadal Þórisson is one of Hólars teachers. He is a very successful trainer, competition rider and breeder as well as being the trainer of Iceland's National team. He was chosen Riding Instructor of the year 2020. See www.isonline.is

Þorsteinn Björnsson has been teaching in Hólar for more than 15 years. He was chosen trainer of the year 2024 in Iceland. He will share from his unique experience from more than a decade of teaching students to ride pace on the school's pace horses.
