Dr. Kathleen M. Gura, PharmD is a clinical pharmacist at Boston Children’s Hospital, where she also serves as Manager of the Clinical Research Program in the Department of Pharmacy and an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at the Harvard Medical School.

Her professional work focuses on pediatric and neonatal parenteral nutrition, including intravenous lipid emulsions, and intestinal failure–associated liver disease (IFALD), with particular emphasis on safe compounding practices. She has extensive experience in clinical research as a principal and co-investigator in federally and industry-funded studies and has contributed to national regulatory and expert initiatives, including work with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. She is the current president from the American Society for Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition (ASPEN) and has authored numerous peer-reviewed publications in pediatric clinical nutrition.
