

Susan Hill – Short Bio

Dr. Susan Hill is a Consultant in Paediatric Gastroenterology and Nutrition at Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children, London, and an Honorary Senior Lecturer at the Institute of Child Health, University College London. She is a core member of the hospital-wide nutrition team, managing intestinal failure and parenteral nutrition, and leads one of the largest UK programs for children on home parenteral nutrition.

Dr. Hill is a member of the ESPGHAN Committee of Nutrition and the BSPGHAN Nutrition and Intestinal Failure Working Group (NIFWG). She has played a key role in developing and updating the ESPGHAN Parenteral Nutrition Guidelines and has contributed extensively to publications focused on intestinal failure rehabilitation, home parenteral nutrition, and short bowel syndrome.
