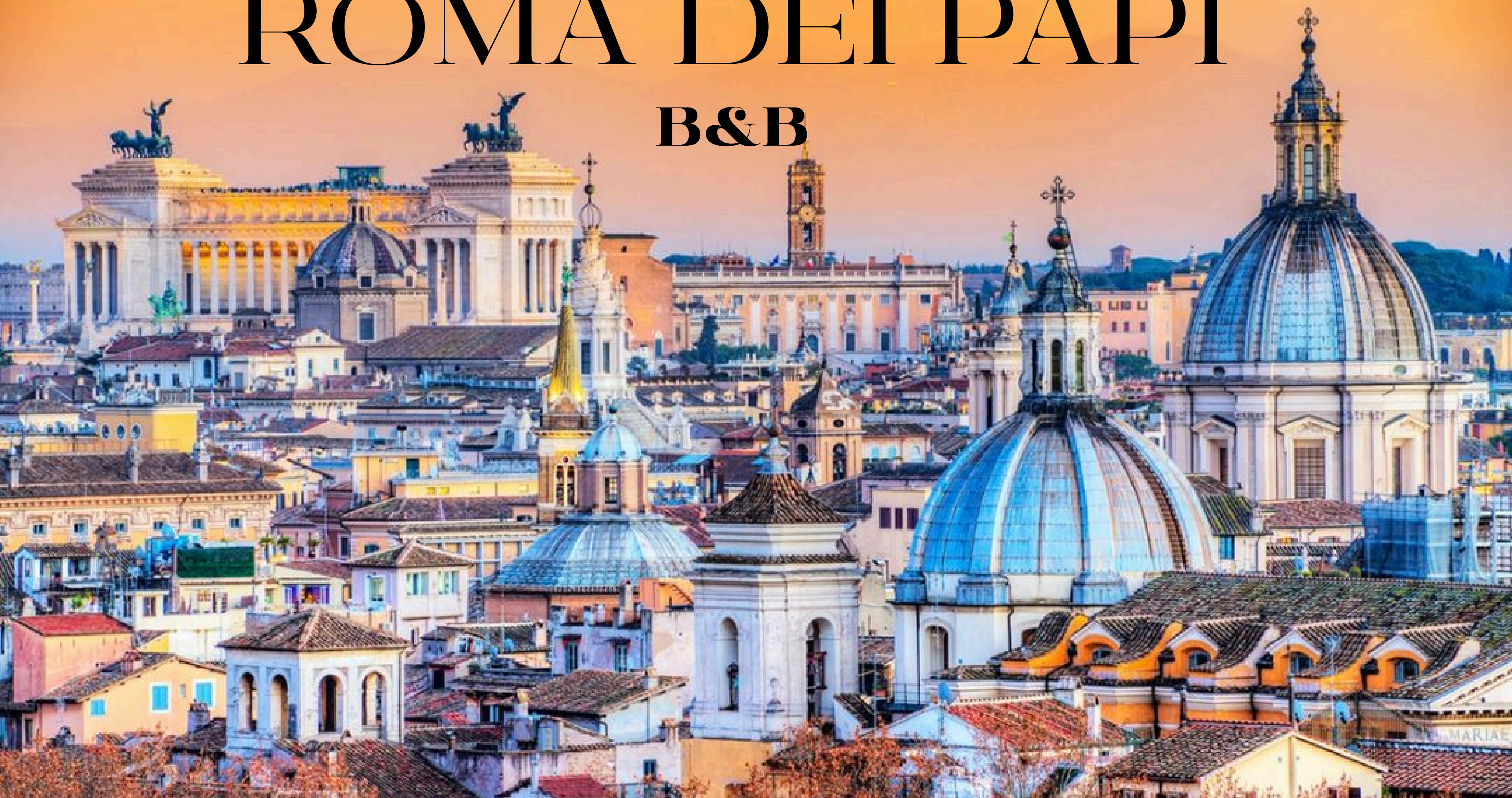

HOW TO REACH US

FROM FCO

1) sitbus shuttle, leaves from the parking area of terminal 3, costs 7 euro per person, you have to get off at the stop called VIA CRESCENZIO 2/VATICANO and then walk less than 3 minutes to reach us in Piazza Adriana 5. 2) we can organize a private car (UP TO 3 PERSONS WITH SMALL/MEDIUM BAGS!), it costs 65 euro with a driver waiting for you at the passport control exit with a sign with your name, for this we need the flight number, name of the flight company, arrival time. From 4 to 6 persons we can organize a minivan, It costs 90/100 euro, one way bags included 3) you can take a taxi, the current cost of the taxi is a fixed price and is 55 euro (up to 3 persons with small/medium bags)

FROM CIA

1) General shuttle bus to take at the exit of airport, it costs approx 7 euro per person, you have to get off at Termini train Station and then use Metro line A following direction Battistini and get out at the stop called LEPANTO, from Lepanto metro station you need to walk approx 10 minutes to reach us in Piazza Adriana 5. 2) we can organize a private car (UP TO 3 PERSONS WITH SMALL/MEDIUM BAGS!), it costs 65 euro with a driver waiting for you at the passport control exit with a sign with your name, for this we need the flight number, name of the flight company, arrival time. From 4 to 6 persons we can organize a minivan, It costs 90/100 euro, one way bags included 3) you can take a taxi, the current cost of the taxi is a fixed price and is 40 euro (up to 3 persons with small/medium bags)

COLOSSEO

With a nice walk of 45 minutes you can reach one of the most iconic monuments in the world, the Colosseum!

The Colosseum, located in the heart of Rome, is an ancient amphitheater and one of the most iconic landmarks in the world. Built between 70-80 AD under the Flavian emperors, it could hold up to 50,000 spectators. The Colosseum hosted gladiatorial contests, public spectacles, and dramatic performances. Its impressive architecture, featuring arches and tiered seating, showcases the engineering prowess of ancient Rome. Despite centuries of damage from natural disasters and stone robbers, it remains a symbol of Roman strength and ingenuity.



How to reach:

You can reach it by walk (45 min) or by subway (30 min).

From LEPANTO station take the A line, direction ANAGNINA, and stop at TERMINI. Once there, follow the directions to the B line and catch it direction LAURENTINA. After 2 stops you will be at the stop COLOSSEO

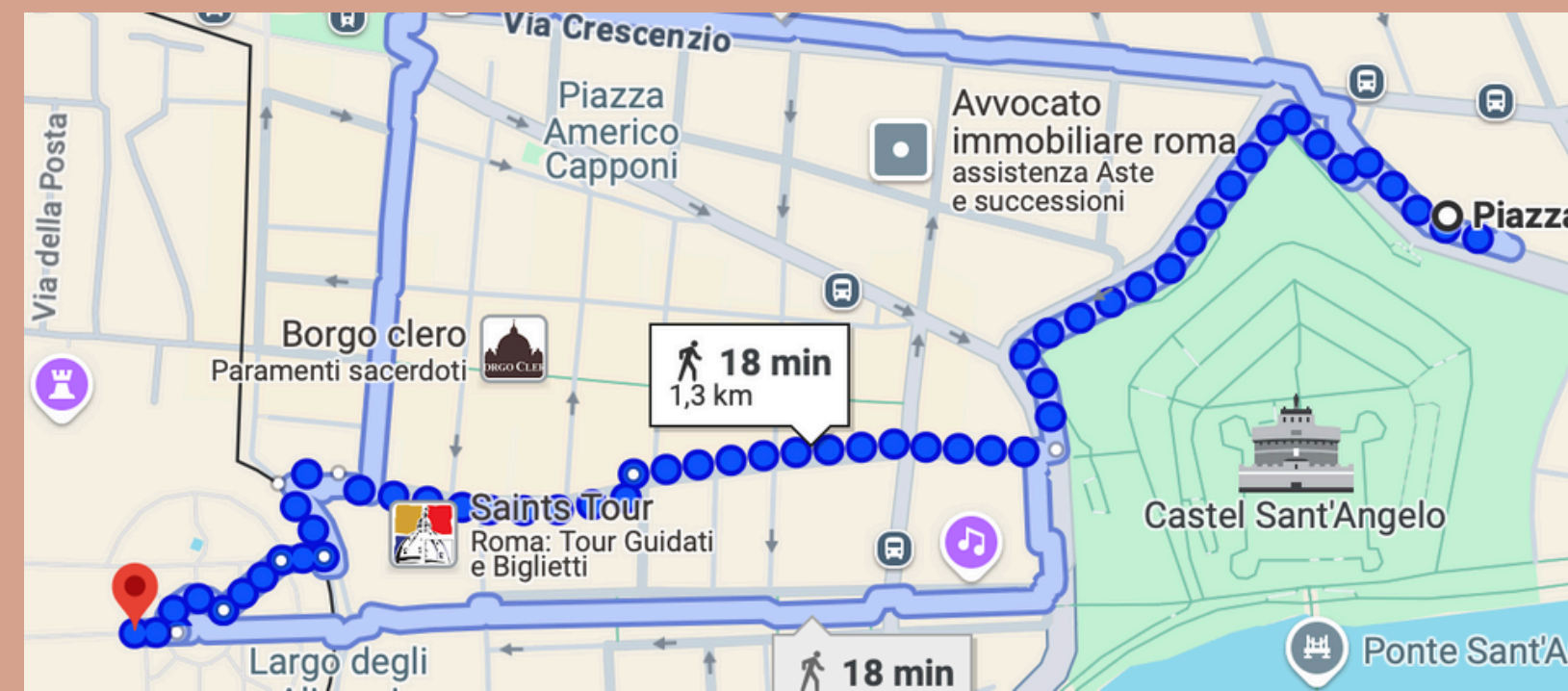
ST. PETER'S BASILICA

Located only 10 min by walk from the B&B, St. Peter's Basilica is one of the most renowned religious sites in the world. It features stunning Renaissance architecture, designed by Michelangelo, Bramante, and Bernini. The basilica boasts an impressive dome that dominates the skyline of Rome. Inside, visitors can admire masterpieces such as Michelangelo's Pietà and the magnificent Baldachin by Bernini. It is a major pilgrimage site and the heart of the Catholic Church.



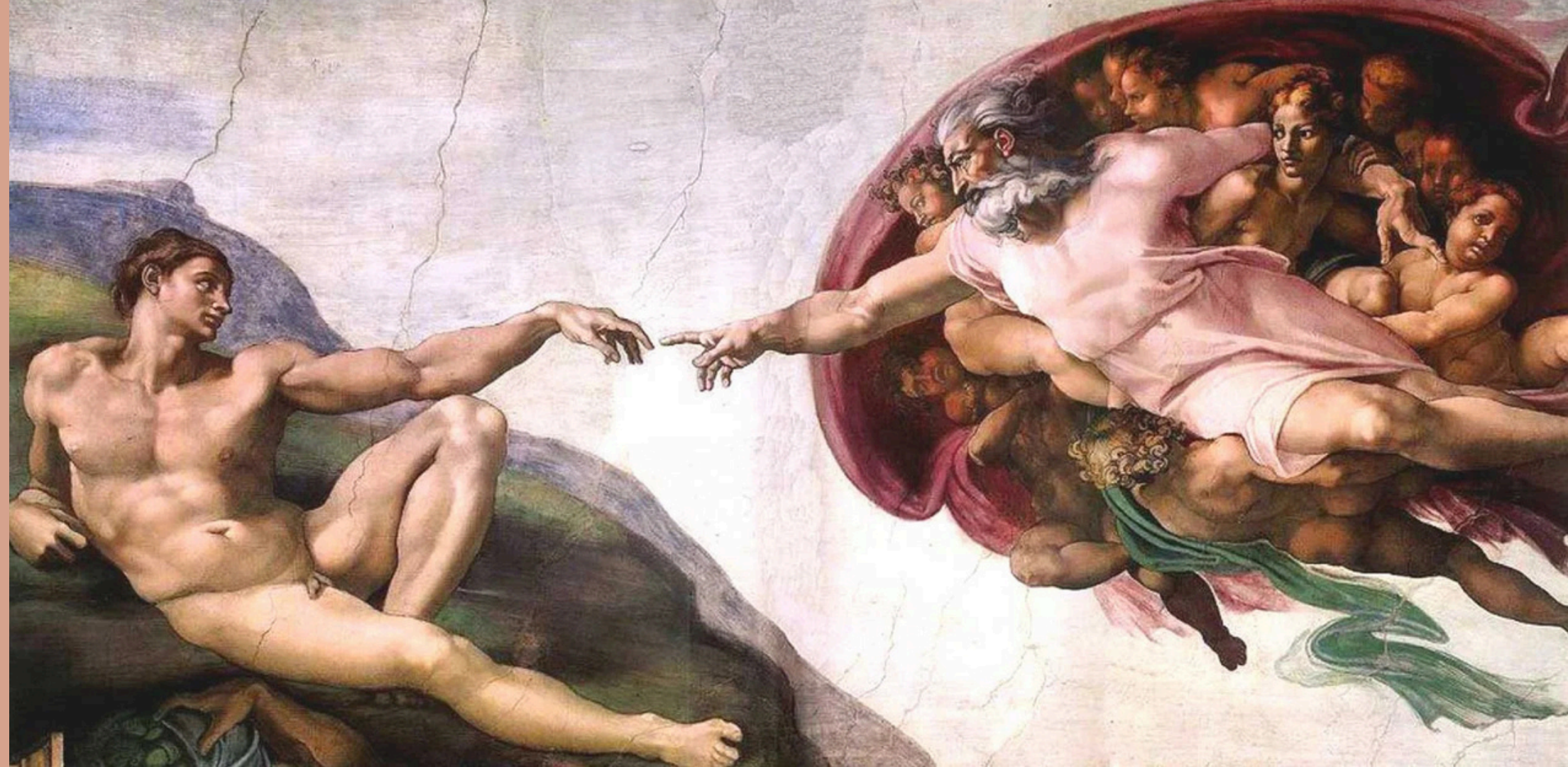
How to reach:

You can reach it by walking directly from the B&B. It will take around 18 min



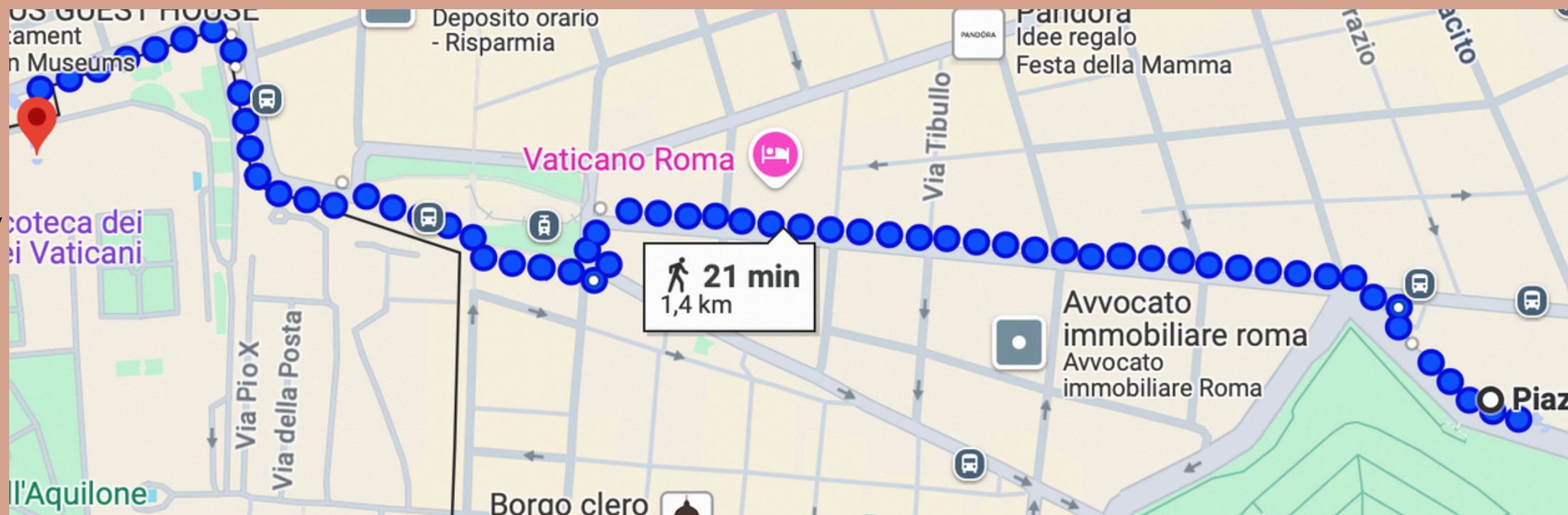
VATICAN MUSEUMS

The Vatican Museums, located within Vatican City, are home to one of the world's most extensive and impressive art collections. How to reach:

You can easily reach it with a walk of 21 min from the B&B.



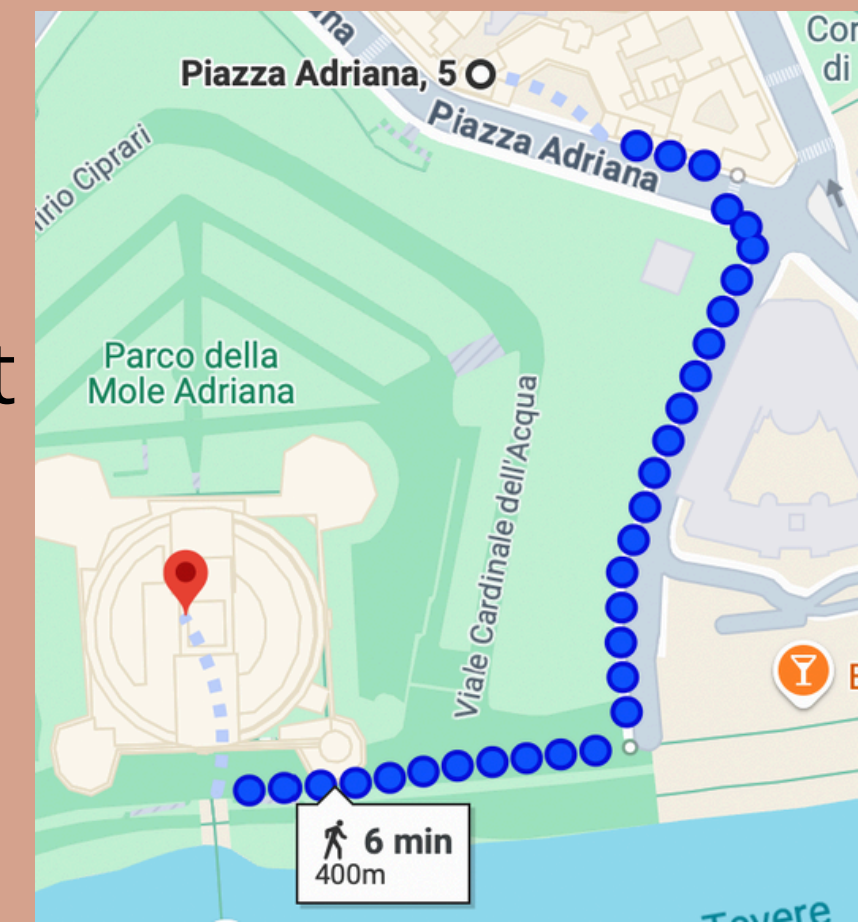
CASTEL SANT'ANGELO

Castel Sant'Angelo, also known as the Mausoleum of Hadrian, is a towering cylindrical fortress. Originally built in the 2nd century AD as a mausoleum for Emperor Hadrian and his family, it later served as a papal residence, fortress, and prison. The structure is connected to the Vatican by the Passetto di Borgo, a fortified corridor. Today, it functions as a museum, offering panoramic views of Rome and showcasing historical artifacts.



How to reach:

Located just in front of the B&B, you can reach it by walk in about 6 min



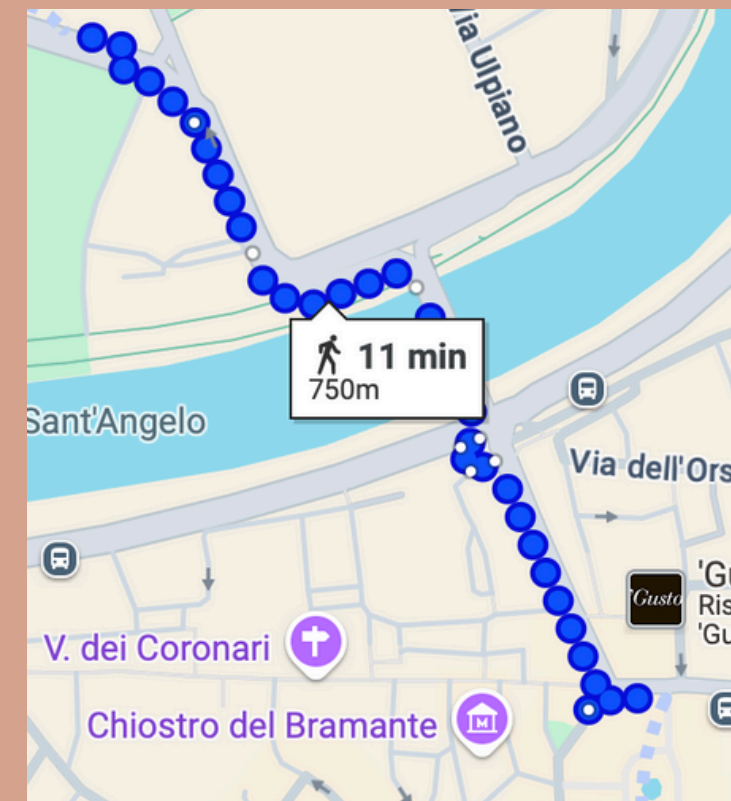
NAVONA SQUARE

Navona Square is a stunning square in the heart of Rome, known for its beautiful Baroque architecture and vibrant atmosphere. It features three magnificent fountains, including the famous Fountain of the Four Rivers by Bernini. Surrounded by charming cafes and historic buildings, it's a lively spot for street artists, tourists, and locals alike.



How to reach:

You can reach it in about 11 min by walk directly from the B&B



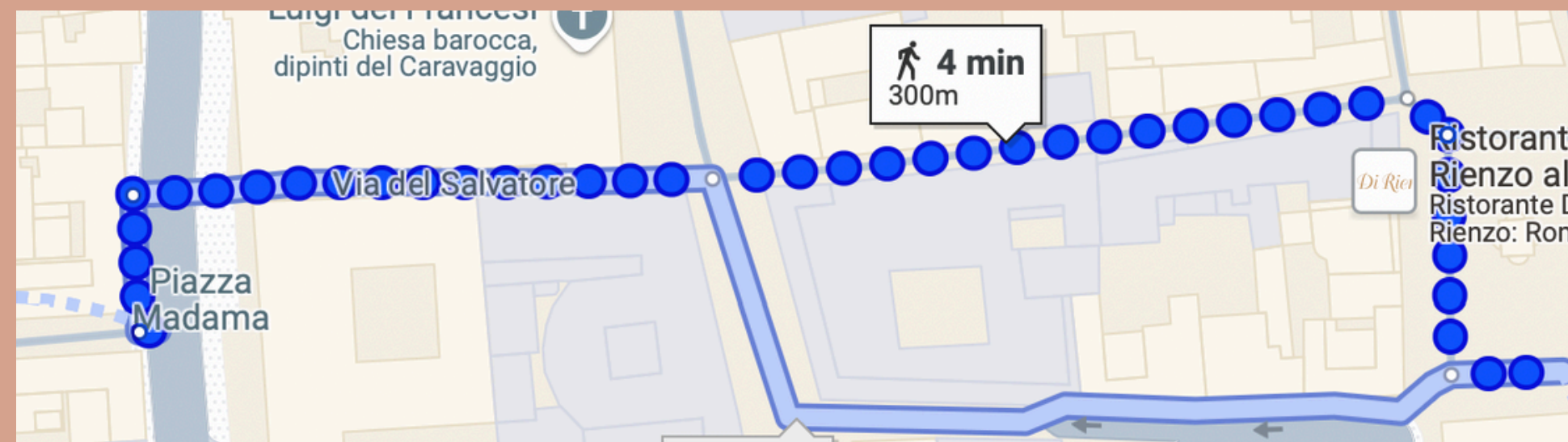
PANTHEON

The Pantheon in Rome is an ancient Roman temple, originally built around 27-25 BC and later rebuilt by Emperor Hadrian around 118-125 AD. It is renowned for its large, unreinforced concrete dome with a central oculus that allows natural light to enter. Dedicated to all the gods, the Pantheon showcases remarkable architectural design and engineering. Today, it serves as a church and a major tourist attraction, reflecting the grandeur of Roman architecture and history.



How to reach:

During your visit of the downtown of Rome, you can easily reach it from Navona Square with a walk of 4 min



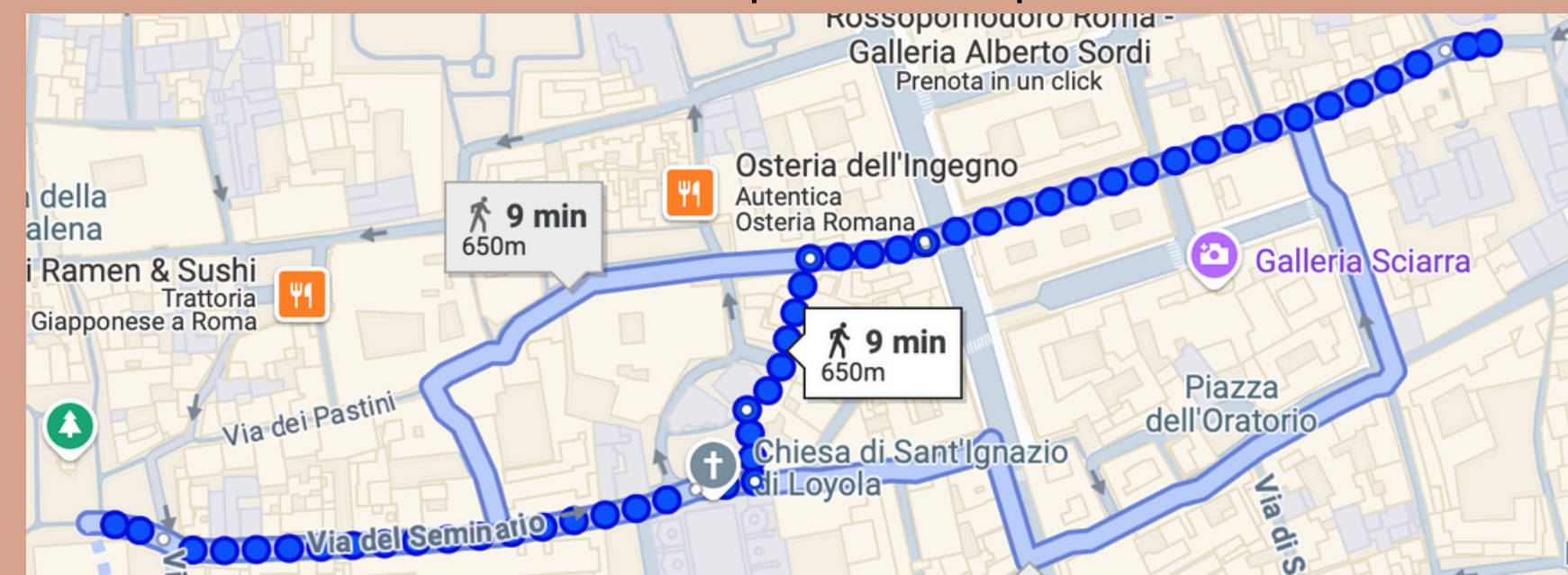
TREVI FOUNTAIN

The Trevi Fountain, located in the heart of Rome, is one of the most famous fountains in the world. Designed by Nicola Salvi and completed by Giuseppe Pannini in 1762, it features a stunning Baroque style. The central figure is Oceanus, the god of the sea, riding a shell-shaped chariot pulled by sea horses, with tritons guiding them. Tourists traditionally toss coins into the fountain to ensure a return to Rome.



How to reach:

You can easily reach it during your visit of the downtown from Pantheon (10 min) or Spanish steps (10 min)



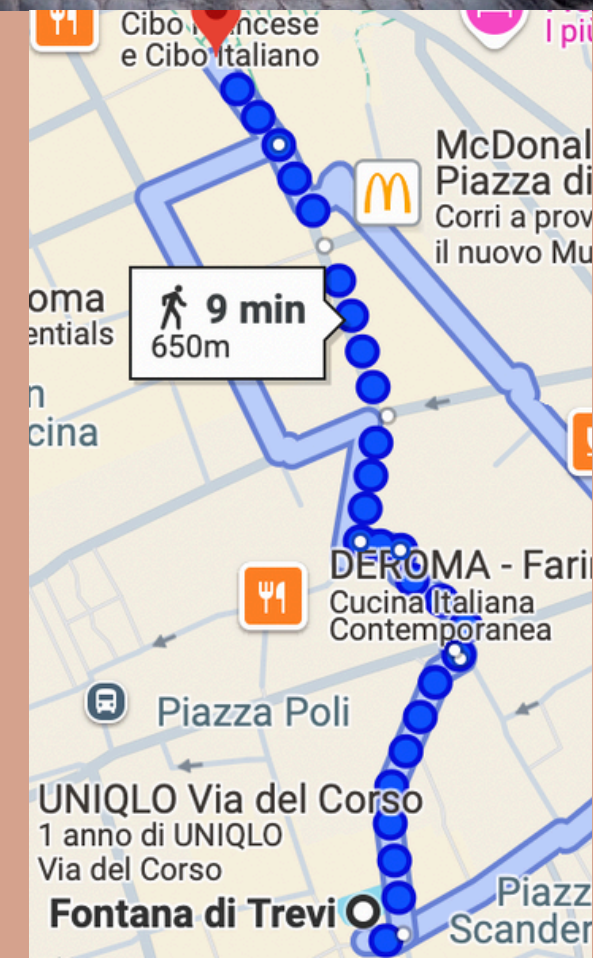
SPANISH STEPS

Piazza di Spagna, located in the heart of Rome, is one of the city's most iconic squares. It is famous for the Spanish Steps, a grand staircase of 135 steps connecting the square to the Trinità dei Monti church above. The square is adorned with the elegant Barcaccia Fountain, designed by Pietro Bernini, and surrounded by historic buildings and luxury boutiques, making it a vibrant hub for tourists and locals alike.



How to reach:

You can easily reach it with the subway (A line) at the stop SPAGNA or by walk during your visit of the Trevi Fountain

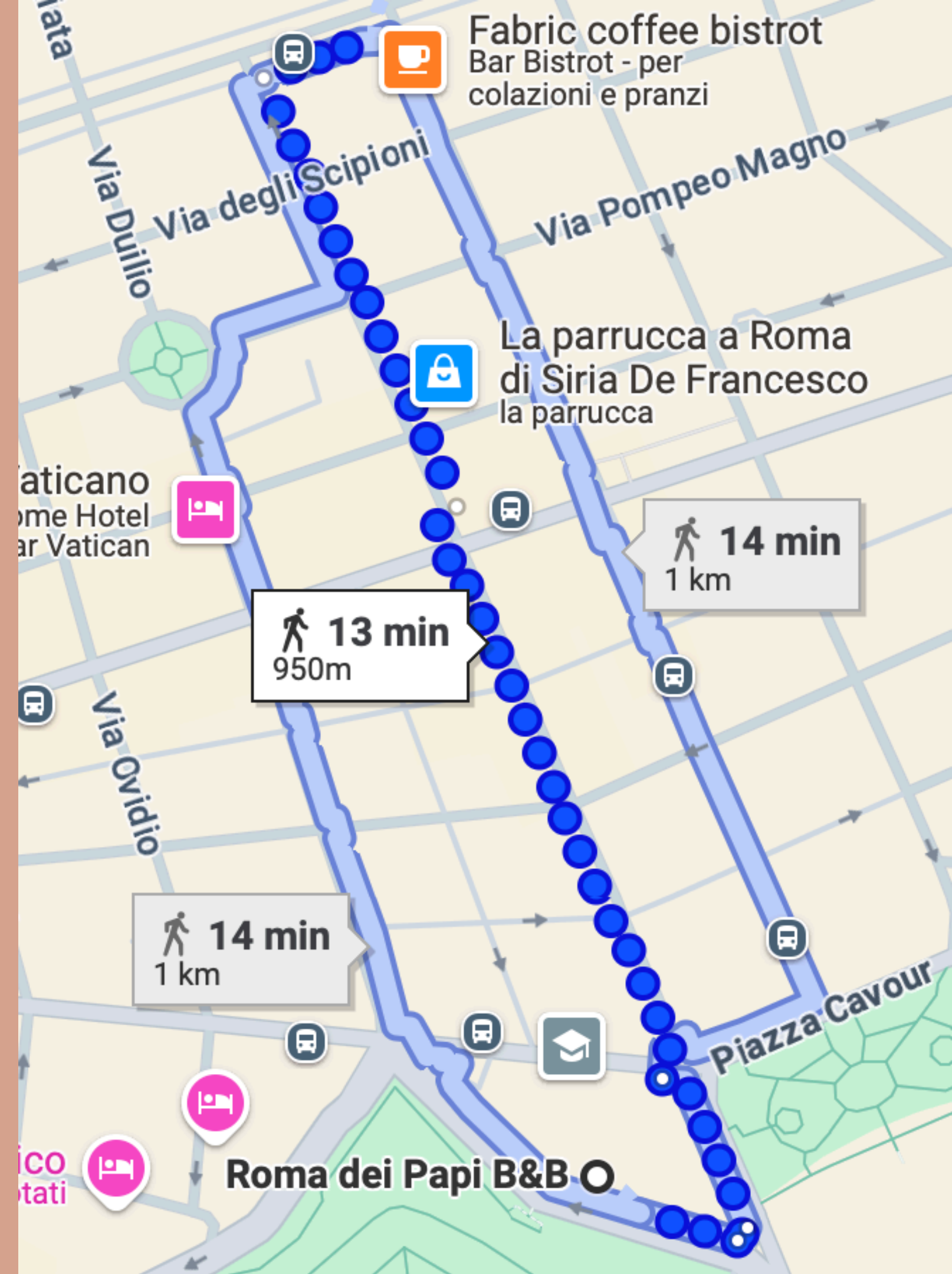
HOW TO REACH THE SUBWAY

inside the station.

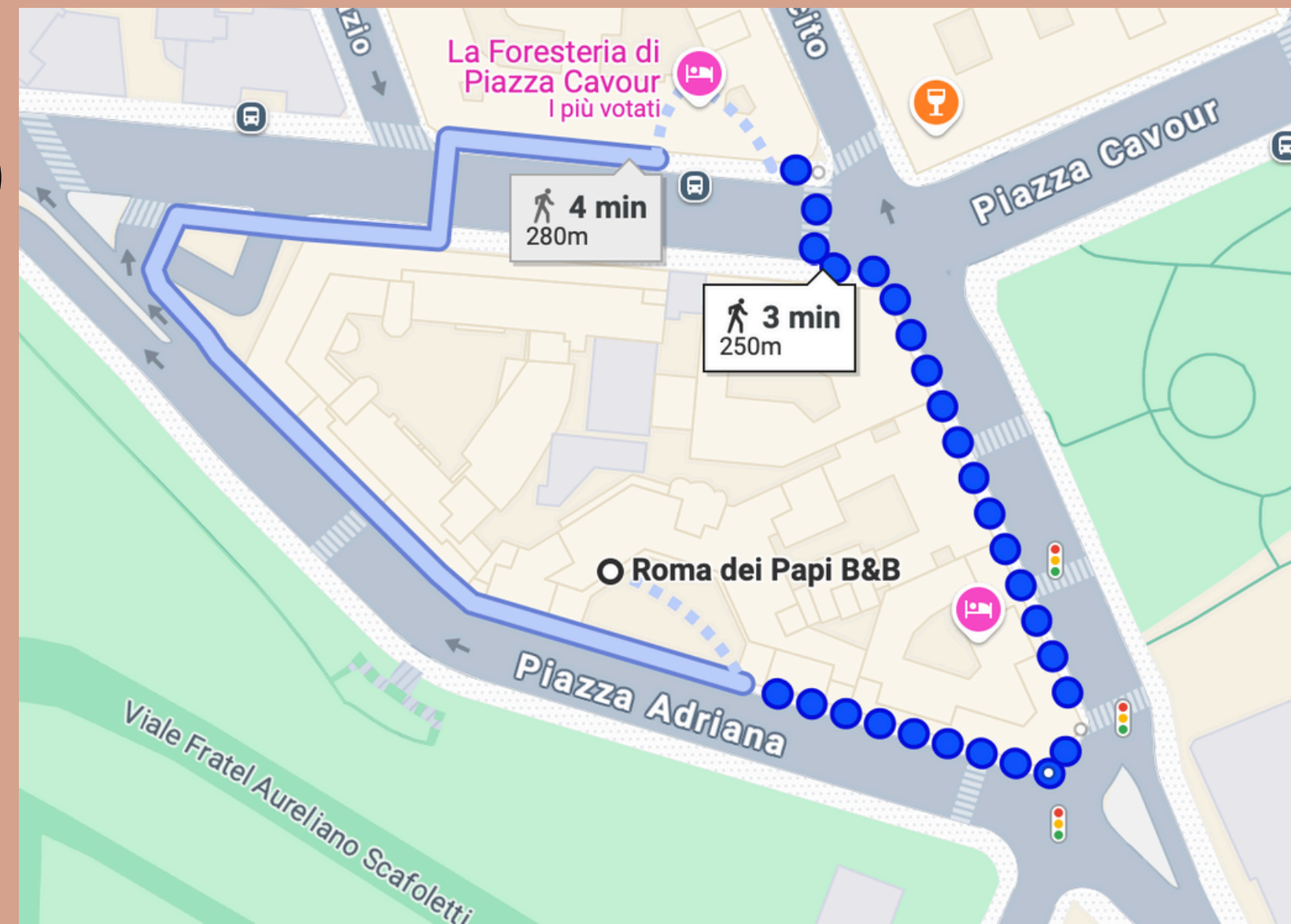
The price for the ticket (BIT) is 1,50€ and you can pay

24H/48H/72H



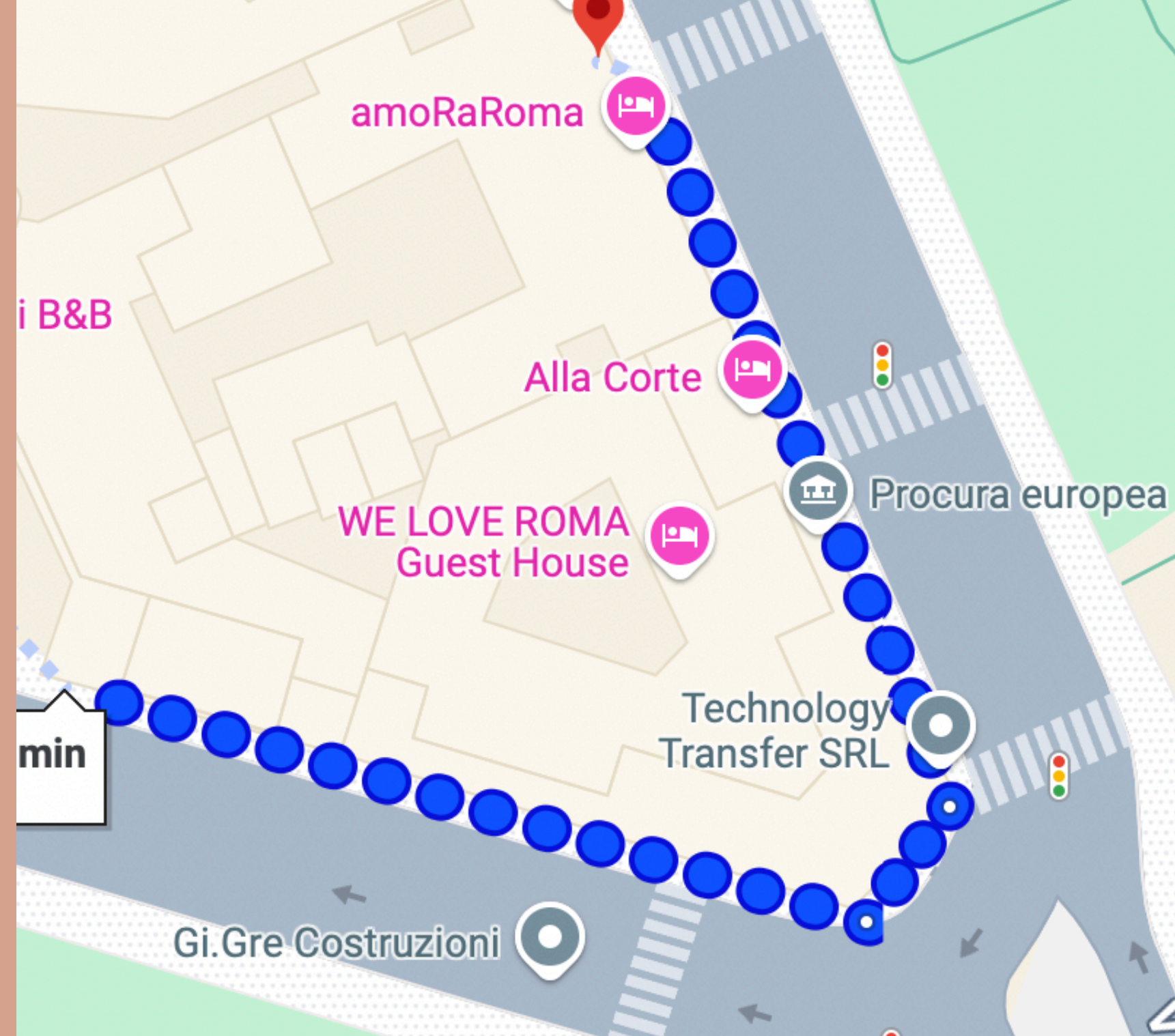
SITBUSSHUTTLE TO FCO

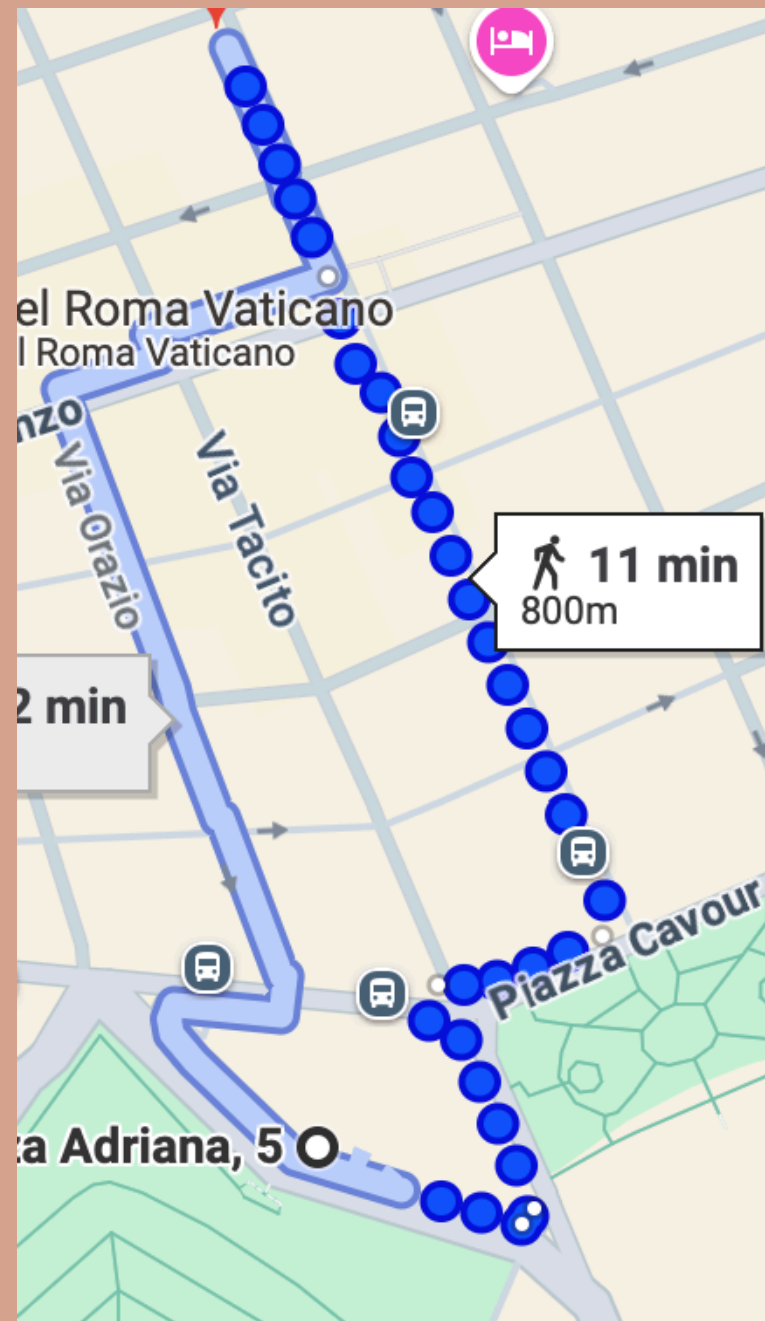

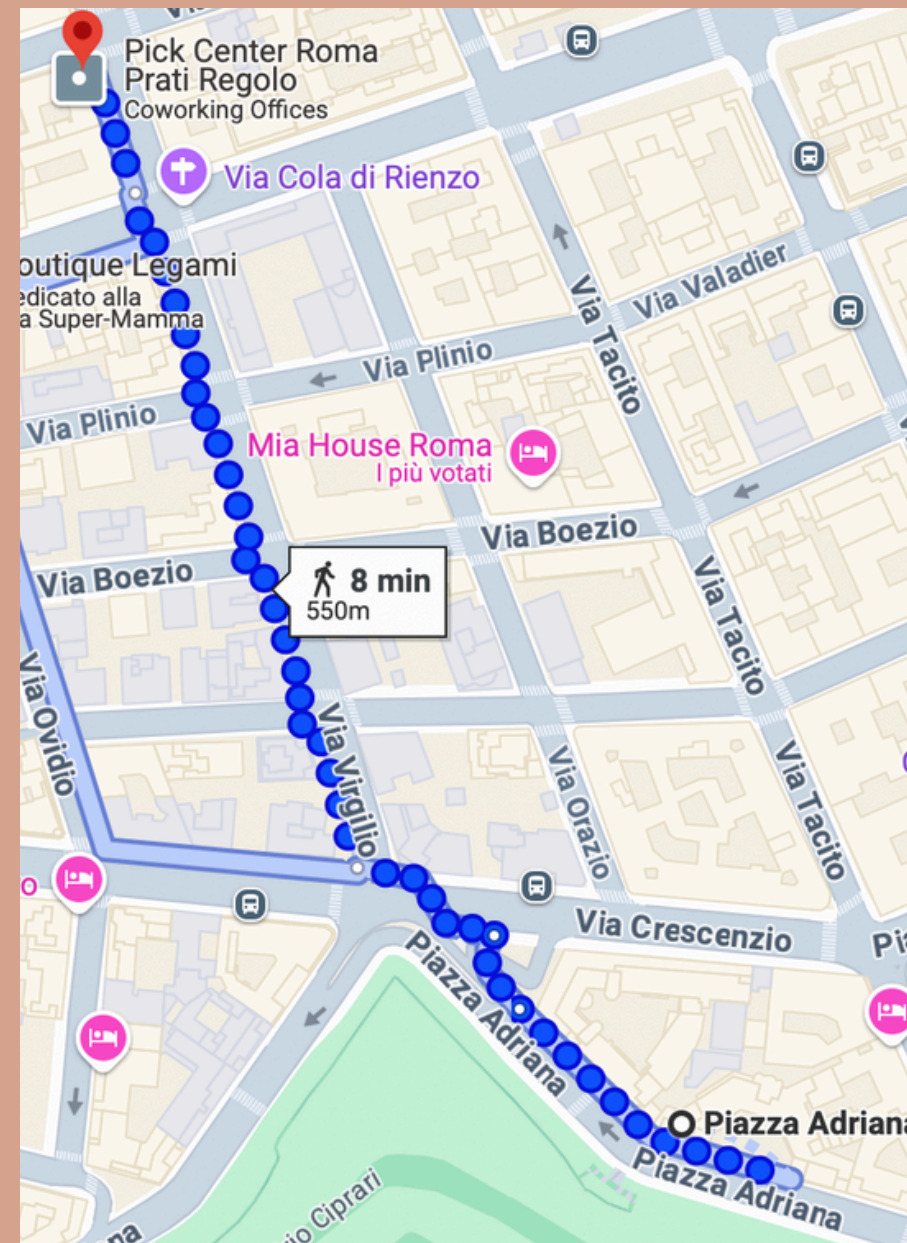

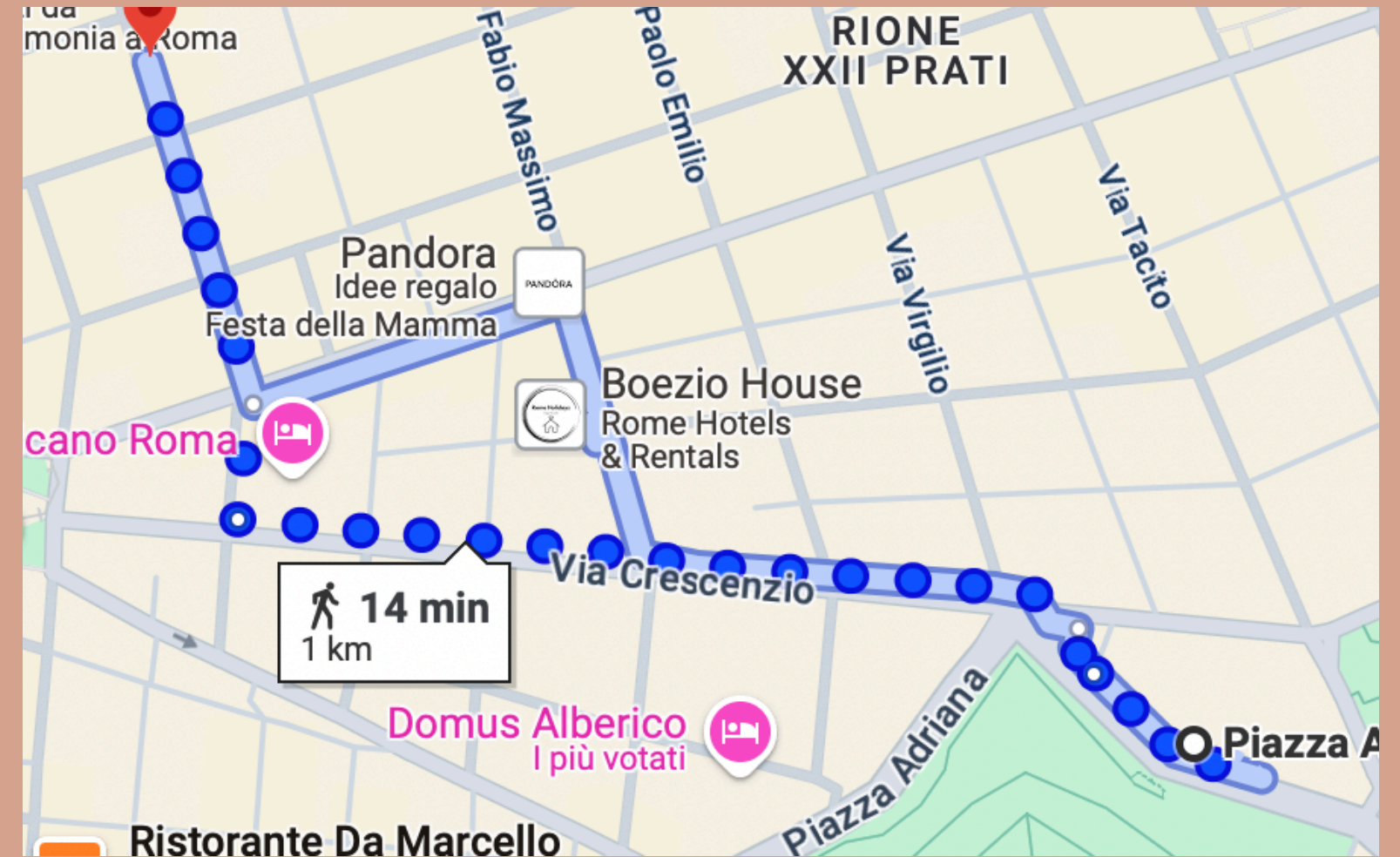
