



## House Rules of the Sports School Oberhaching

As of: January 1, 2026

### Welcome

The team at the Sportschule Oberhaching strives at all times to make every guest's stay as pleasant as possible. The Sportschule is intended to be an optimal venue for training and professional development, as well as a place for relaxation. We therefore ask that you treat the facilities and equipment with care, show consideration for one another, and observe the House Rules.

### Registration

- All guests must register at the reception desk.
- The Course Director is responsible for ensuring the proper registration of all participants.
- The duty of supervision for minor participants rests with the Course Director throughout the entire duration of the stay.

### Facilities and Equipment

- Rooms, sports facilities, and sports equipment must be treated with care and left in a clean condition.
- Please conserve energy: do not leave lights or electronic devices switched on unnecessarily.
- Please close windows and doors when leaving rooms or seminar areas.
- An absolute smoking ban applies throughout the entire Sportschule premises.
- Alcoholic beverages are available only to persons aged 18 and older.
- Bringing alcohol or illicit drugs onto the premises is prohibited.
- Bringing animals onto the premises is not permitted.
- Entry into the building is prohibited while barefoot or wearing soccer cleats.
- Persons under the age of 18 may not use the swimming pool, sauna, or weight room unsupervised.
- Rooms must be vacated by 10:30 a.m. on the day of departure.
- Luggage storage is available only in the designated luggage room located in the basement.

### Use of Sports Facilities

- The swimming pool and weight room are open from 7:15 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Use is restricted exclusively to resident guests or those with a confirmed booking.
- During scheduled course times, the presence of the responsible Course Director is mandatory.
- Additionally, the specific usage regulations posted within each respective facility must be observed.

### Electronic Devices

- Electric kettles, coffee machines, and similar appliances are prohibited.
- Charging cables may only be used under supervision and must be unplugged once charging is complete.

### In-Room Safe

- Valuables must be stored in the in-room safe.
- Do not store food items in the safe.

### Quiet Hours

- Quiet hours begin at 10:00 PM and end at 6:30 AM.
- In the event of violations, the security service may intervene.

## Meals

- Breakfast: 6:30 AM – 9:30 AM.
- Lunch: 11:30 AM – 2:00 PM.
- Dinner: 5:30 PM – 8:00 PM.
- Tableware may not be removed from the dining hall.
- Outside food and beverages are not permitted.

## Liability / Damages

- Each user is liable for damages resulting from improper use.
- The Sports School is liable only in cases of intentional misconduct or gross negligence.
- Any damages must be reported immediately at the reception desk.
- No liability is assumed for damage to vehicles.

## Room Keys and Departure

- The room key card must be carried with you whenever you leave the room.
- Upon departure, please return the key card to the reception desk.
- A fee of €10 will be charged for lost or damaged key cards.

## Enforcement of House Rules

All Sports School staff members are authorized to intervene in cases of non-compliance.
