Rules of the Spielgruppen (playgroups)

Aim of the Playgroups

Our playgroups offer children of similar ages, the opportunity to play together. The children learn and grow together; experiencing, learning and discovering different materials and forms of play. The children build first friendships and share joy and tears together. In the group the children learn to communicate with each other and express their own needs to one another. Children practice patience and conflict resolution with their peers.

Content and Structure

For the Children: painting, colouring, playing, kneading, working, singing, walking, jumping, listening to stories, making music, snack time (Znüni), quiet time etc. For the Parents: every year an information evening takes place. Your child should bring slippers or non slip socks and a small snack and drink with him/her.

Days, Times and Places

The playgroups take place in the mornings during weekdays (except school and public holidays). You can register your child for more than 1 half day. Details of when and where the playgroups are available can be found on the registration form.

The playgroups are at Zürichstrasse 27, 8306 Brüttisellen.

Registrations, Entrance, Withdrawal, Costs

Your registration is usually for an entire school year. The following priorities apply when allocating the limited number of places to children...1. Existing playgroup members seeking a place on additional days, 2. New registration from non-members.

A half day costs 33 CHF We also charge 20 CHF per quarter for the costs of materials (80 CHF per year.)

The bill is sent to you in advance of the quarter (in August, October, December and April). Entrance in the middle of a school year is charged on a pro rata basis. If a child is withdrawn mid quarter, fees are payable up until the end of that quarter. Absences of a child from the playgroup do not entitle you to a discount or money back as the place has already been reserved for that child despite his/her absence.

Insurance

Illness and Accident Insurance is the responsibility of the parent.
