Easter Egg Collection Challenge, Food Bank Drop Off Point & Reverse Advent Calendar

In support of **Hope For Food**, we worked with our local network of donors, friends and partners, including **The Village Hotel & Leisure Club Bournemouth**, to help us collect as much as we could for their various **food bank campaigns**

- We collected **260** Easter Eggs which filled an entire car!
- We **collected various food and clothing donations** throughout the year, also completing a reverse advent calendar in November

MYTIME Young Carers Making Memories Day

Three members of our team **volunteered** for the day to support young carers at a local outdoor activity day

- **Seeing first-hand** how the charity delivers its support and the positive impact it makes to young carers

MYTIME Young Carers Employability Programme - Oceania Cruise Ship Visit

We **hosted a special ship visit** and lunch with our travel partner **Oceania Cruises** for a group of 16-18 year old young carers to inspire and educate them about careers in travel and cruising

SELECT WORLD TRAVEL FOUNDATION TEAM CHALLENGE



On Monday 25th August our team “Just Plane Mad” took on the challenge of pulling a Boeing 737, weighing in at 35,000kg, a distance of 50 metres to raise money for MYTIME Young Carers charity.

We have been incredibly proud to support this amazing cause in 2025, which works so hard within our community to support young carers across Dorset & the Isle of Wight. **MYTIME focuses on providing opportunities that young carers need and deserve, which allows them to thrive and lead happy, healthy lives.**

They provide:

- **Opportunities** to unwind, experience new things and meet other young carers on activity days
- **Fun breaks** away at R&R retreat centres on the Jurassic Coast
- **Online youth groups** where they can come together with other young carers
- **Support to schools** so that they can better support young carers
- An **Employability Programme** to help young carers find their way into further education, training or work



This challenge helped us raise funds and spread the word about the amazing support MYTIME Young Carers give to our community.

Thanks to everyone's effort, we reached an incredible £1,642.50 including Gift Aid!



In October, as a result of our fundraising success, we were thrilled to support Home Start Wessex with our very first grant of £1900, which was donated via The Big Give campaign and doubled to £3800!

The grant was used to set up a new Bumps & Babies group in Dorset, run by the charity, which provides vital early intervention for vulnerable pregnant women and families with babies under the age of one.

In 2024, at another local group, 36 families attended with 100% struggling with their mental health. Other complex issues they will be facing include domestic violence, substance misuse, disability, long-term illness or child development delays.

One parent said “The group gave me a purpose, structure and routine. I always looked forward to Thursday. The care and compassion they gave, helped me to be more confident”.
