Our Spring 2025 trip is based in Norwich the 'City of Stories'. We will stop en route in Stamford and then on to Downham market. We ride on the Bure Valley Railway to Wroxham, sail on the Norfolk Broads, visit East Runton Old Vicarage Gardens, Cromer and Holt. We also enjoy a guided tour of Norwich and its Cathedral to hear about its stories and visit Holkham Hall and its Gardens, take a sail out to see the seals and visit the quaint town of Wells. We will stop en route on the way home in Kings Lynn to learn about this Port, its famous captain and enjoy its market.



To enable us to see the most of the area, we are staying at the Best Western Signature, George Hotel, Norwich which is ideally situated on the edge of Norwich to enable us to explore the town when we have free time. An independently run boutique hotel with recently refurbished rooms and a reputation for good food. The hotel is situated in a quiet conservation area 10 minutes walk from the city centre and has a cosy bar area. We will have our own dining room in which to enjoy breakfast and dinner.

Proposed Itinerary

09.30 Thursday 27th March Depart from Wollaton Travel. We head for Stamford for a break, having free time to explore at leisure. Then to Downham Market to wander around this historic town. We aim to arrive at our Hotel in Norwich by 4.30 pm with time to explore, before dinner.



Friday After Breakfast we head to Aylsham to board the Bure Valley Railway narrow railway to ride to Wroxham with time for lunch before boarding our boat to sail the Broads. Dinner
Saturday After breakfast we go to East Ruston Old Vicarage Gardens to see this evolving garden before heading to Cromer for a crab lunch (not incl)! We then have free time exploring Holt. The prettiest Georgian Town. Dinner

Sunday Breakfast. We enjoy Norwich with a guided tour to hear about the 'Stories' and learn of its history, with free time before having a guided tour of the 900 year Cathedral, which dominates the city in the afternoon. Dinner

Monday Breakfast. Holkham Hall the UK's most pioneering and sustainable rural estate to see how this hall and grounds are developing. We then take a boat ride out to the Seal Colony and hopefully see the pups. We call in at the pretty town of Wells on the way back with its quaint streets. Dinner
Tuesday 1st April After our farewell breakfast we head to Kings Lynn. It is market day with plenty to see, we have a tour of one of England's foremost important ports. Fine old merchants' houses, cobbled lanes and inhabitants. We stop in Rutland on the way home for a break at the Gates Garden Centre. Arriving back about 18.00
