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Our Autumn 2024 trip is to Northumberland based in the heart of the fabulous countryside to enable us to visit the local points of interest and have time to explore. We will stop en route at Ripon with its Cathedral and museums and ride on the Tanfield Railway. During our stay we visit Lindisfarne, the Holy Island, Bamborough castle, Armstrong's Cragside; Alnwick & Barter Books and Beamish. We have a guided tour of Durham and see its cathedral. We return via Richmond and Wentworth Garden Centre and Gardens.



To enable us to see the most of the area, we are staying at the lovely **4* Linden Hall Golf & Country Club**, nr Morpeth set in fabulous grounds with great views. There are several walks around the grounds along with a pitch and put, leisure centre and separate pub. We enjoy the locally sourced produce, from the surrounding area in their intimate wood panelled restaurant as we stay on half board. The Northumberland breakfasts are great! The hotel was originally a private Mansion built in 1812 and has a fantastic cantilevered staircase and hall, with a unique charm, combined with all the modern facilities you would expect. The lounges and bar are also very comfortable in which to sit and chat.

Wednesday Breakfast. We go to Durham for a light hearted guided tour and then free time to explore this UNESCO City. We call in at the Angel of the North on the way home. Dinner.

Thursday Breakfast. We head to Cragside, William Armstrong fabulous residence in the hills, being the first house powered by hydro electricity. We then head to Alnwick to visit Barter books and then free time to explore this quaint market town with its cafes and castle(not incl) . Dinner

Friday 11th October. After our farewell breakfast we head to Richmond with time to explore this market town. We head home stopping at Wentworth Garden Centre with its great tea rooms and display gardens before getting back to Nottingham around 17.30.
