**Wednesday.** Breakfast. We have a walking tour uncovering Falmouth's colourful past full of stories, laughs and surprises. In the afternoon we have a River cruise on the beautiful Helford River with a commentary seeing Manderlay House, Durgan, Trebah, Port Navas, Dinner

**Thursday** Breakfast. We visit the Lost Gardens of Heligan, to see how the renovation work is continuing protecting wildlife, support biodiversity and hear stories of nature's regeneration over the 200 acre site.
