Our 2026 overseas trip is exploring the **Channel Islands Jersey, Guernsey, & Sark**. We have a home pick-up to fly from East Midlands to Jersey and then to Guernsey with a day trip to Sark. These beautiful islands have plenty to explore and we have Island tours of all three to help with the history. We also visit the War Tunnels, Glass Church, Elizabeth Castle, Jersey Zoo and Samares botanical gardens. We fly to Guernsey from Jersey and include a half day island tour and a visit to the Castle Cornet with free time to explore St Peter Port. We then have a day trip to Sark to explore this little Island which is full of history.

Proposed Itinerary

Saturday 10th October Home pick-up for your accompanied flight to Jersey and then on our arrival coach transfers to the Pomme D'Or, St Helier for four nights. We have free time to explore before dinner.



Sunday. Breakfast. We have a **guided tour** of Jersey with a commentary explaining the history of the island. We will stop off at several points along the way. Light lunch included. Dinner

Monday. Breakfast. Visit to the Glass Church with works by Rene Lalique. Then on to the Jersey War Tunnels to see the story of the Nazi invasion. In the afternoon we go by amphibious vehicle to Elizabeth Castle to enjoy the dramatic castle, home to St Helier. Dinner

Tuesday. Breakfast. Our visit to Jersey Zoo and the Gerald Durrells Conservation Trust, a great experience followed by an afternoon visit to the Botanical Gardens of Samares Manor with a tour. Dinner

Wednesday Breakfast. Free time before our midday flight to Guernsey and our next hotel for three nights the Best Western Moores. We have free time, maybe visit the nearby Guernsey Museum & gardens at Candie. Dinner

Thursday Breakfast. Island tour seeing the ancient and modern history of the island. We have time to visit Castle Cornet famous for its midday gun, Island history and great views. Dinner.

Friday Breakfast. Ferry to Sark for the day where we have a tour of the island by horse drawn cart and learn about their unique history and local government. Dinner in Guernsey

Saturday Leisurely breakfast with free time before our flight to EMA and transfer home.

For the day trip to Sark you will need to be reasonably agile due to the landing at Creux Harbour which is by steep steps.
For operational reasons this itinerary may change.
