Picton castle, with over 700 years of history a medieval fortress with graceful Georgian interiors are unique. Gwili Railway is one of the UK's most picturesque preserved lines. Set in beautiful countryside the line follows the River Gwili on a steady uphill journey through farmland and wooded hillsides. The National Botanic Garden of Wales is a 568-acre garden with themed gardens, a glasshouse, and a nature reserve, dedicated to conservation and the arts. St Davids where we have a humorous tour of this pretty city with its quaint streets, cute cafes, boutiques and galleries followed by a visit to the Bug farm which showcases the sustainable future of food, farming and wildlife conservation and Yes you can try a few if you dare!! Tenby, a historic town located in Wales, known for its castle walls, Victorian architecture, and beautiful coastline and pretty port from where we go to Caldey Island. The Cistercian monks of Caldey continue a tradition which began there in Celtic times. More than a thousand years of prayer and quiet living have made this remote and beautiful island a haven of tranquility and peace with plenty to see including red squirrels, seals and puffins. Our final visit on our way home is to The Royal Mint Experience, where we see the United Kingdom's coins being made. We go behind the scenes to follow the journey of a coin from a blank to a bank on the Guided Factory Experience.
