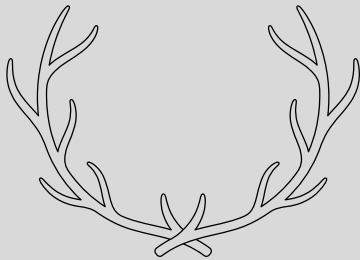

Repairs and Maintenance

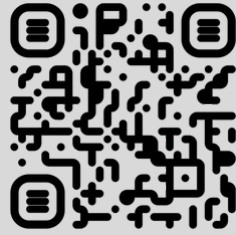

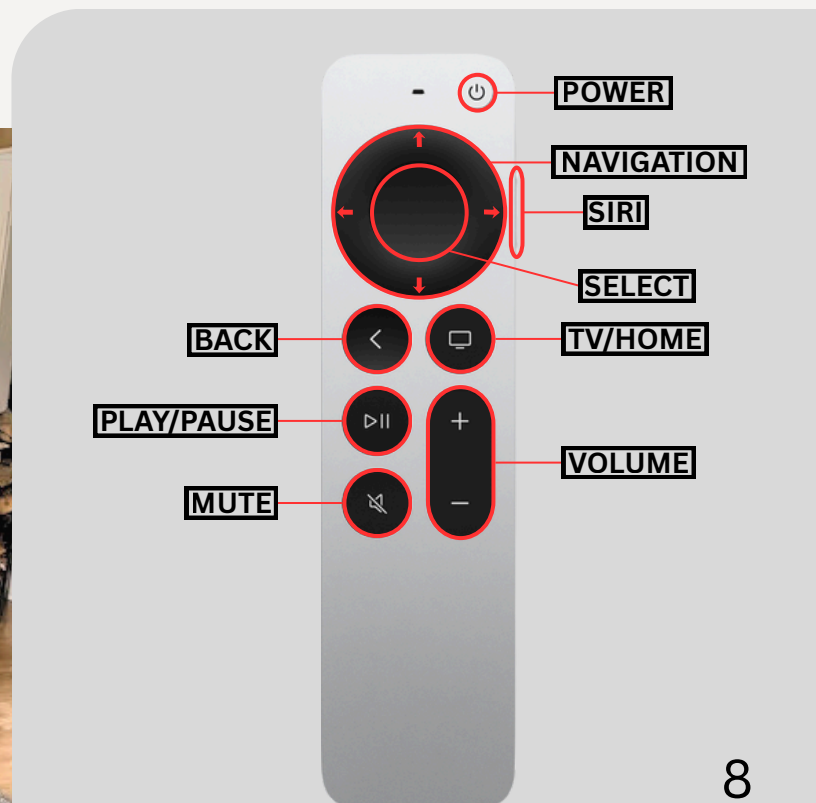


TV Instructions

1. Press the **POWER** button to turn the TV and the Apple TV on or off.
2. Swipe or click around with the **NAVIGATION** ring to move through menus and apps to the selections you would like.
3. Press the center to **SELECT** which options you would like.
4. Press the **BACK** button to return to the previous screen.
5. Press the **TV/HOME** button to go to the AppleTV+ screen. Press and hold to return to the Home Screen. Double click to access open app switcher or to completely close an app by swiping up.
6. Press **PLAY/PAUSE** to start or pause whichever content you need. Not all content may allow this feature.
7. Use the **VOLUME (+ / -)** on the bottom right to control the sound level.
8. Press the **MUTE** button to quickly silence the TV.
9. Press and hold the **SIRI** button and speak clearly to utilize the voice search.

Troubleshooting

1. Close and reopen app if it is not responding, using the double click feature with the **TV/HOME** button.
2. Quick reset if it stops responding: Press and hold **BACK + -VOLUME** together for about 5 seconds until the status light flashes on the AppleTV device.
3. Check to see if the remote needs charging. There is a charging port on the bottom of the remote.

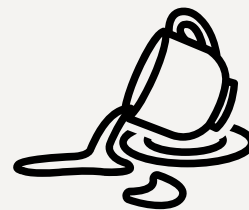
Parking
