

How to connect to Wi-Fi

Starting from the main page, press the LEFT ARROW key until you reach the Wi-Fi settings page. It has the following icon in the upper left corner.



This page shows information on the current Wi-Fi status.

1. Press the STAR key and the RIGHT ARROW. The magnifying glass icon should now be blinking.
2. Press the ENTER key. The machine should now start scanning for available network.
3. When scanning is complete, select the desired Wi-Fi network with the ARROW keys and then ENTER.
4. A keyboard should appear on screen now to enter the password. Use the ARROW keys to select the correct letters and confirm with ENTER. There are 3 keyboard pages that can be cycled through using the STAR key. Keep in mind that passwords are case sensitive and capital letters cannot be substituted with non-capital letters.
5. When you've entered the password, select the "Enter" symbol and press ENTER.



If everything was done correctly, the machine should now connect to the Wi-Fi network. If it can't connect to the network, repeat the above steps and make sure the password is correct.

If the machine cannot find any Wi-Fi networks after step 2, press and hold the STAR key to re-initialize the Wi-Fi and then try again.

If the machine still cannot find any networks, you can use your smartphone to create a mobile hotspot with the network name "DNG" and the password "DNGR1.2022". Reset the machine by selecting the "Factory reset" icon in page 3. The machine should now automatically connect to the DNG network and should now be able to scan for other networks. Once you've connected to a new network, you can disable the mobile hotspot.



How to create a Wi-Fi access point on the machine

As described above, navigate to the Wi-Fi settings page.

1. Press the STAR key. The Wi-Fi icon should now be blinking →
2. Press the UP key. The magnifying glass icon should now disappear, and the Wi-Fi icon should change to the following →



The machine should now create its own Wi-Fi access point that other machines can connect to. This access point is open and needs no password. Keep in mind there's no internet access on this access point, but it can be used to connect machines together.
