HOW TO INCREASE ...

Written bid submission:

The simplest and safest way is still an order form, with or without a preview by post or fax (+49) 0221 382 1324

TELEPHONE BIDDING (0049) 0212 382 13 20:

If you would like to bid directly by telephone, let us know which lots you would like to bid on at least one day before the auction date. Registration is also considered a minimum bid. You will be called by us - shortly before the lot is called - and you can be reached immediately. We provide telephone and staff for bidding and are the responsibility of the bidder.

Spontaneous changes during the auction are not possible. Telephone bidding is only suitable if you would like to bid significantly higher than the estimate in your own spontaneity. If no connection is established, it is not the responsibility of the auctioneer; a deferral because no connection is established cannot take place (due to the knockdown in live online bidding). To be on the safe side, please also provide your landline or mobile number as a replacement.

PREVIEW:

The pre-viewing for individuals is possible from April 11th, to April 18th, except on Sunday April 16th, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. You are also welcome to call in advance of the auction and inquire about the nature of the lots.

Previous participation in the hall:

The most successful classic auction participation was personal bidding with a preview in the hall. This is e.g. Currently not possible due to the "Corona crisis". The combination of a preview and live bidding is an equivalent alternative with an increase in comfort for everyone. Those who do not have access can instead participate in writing or by telephone.

A new option that we successfully tested as a Comfort and as an alternative with Auction 191 (Internet only) offer for the hall:

Live bidding - BIDDING

You take part in the auction directly via biddr. You register at www.biddr.com and after confirmation you can submit pre-bids or take part in the auction live using the access granted to you. Registration can only take place up to 1 day before the auction.

Live Bidding - BID

You take part in the auction directly via biddr.

You register at www.biddr.com and after confirmation you can place preliminary bids or participate live in the auction using the access you have been given.

Registration can only take place up to 1 day before the auction (security password 8 characters!).

To participate in our online auction, please proceed as follows:

1. Open <https://www.biddr.com/auctions/muenzzentrum/> in your web browser and click on the live bidding button. Sign up if you don't already have an account and log in.
2. Open the page from point 1 again and click on the blue live bidding button again. Follow the instructions to register as a live bidder. Please note that we have to check and activate your approval manually. So please register early.
3. As soon as you have been admitted, you can open the page from point 1 again on the day of the auction and click on the blue live bidding button. After logging in, you will be taken directly to live bidding, where you can then bid.
